Denture(s) Addendum:

Leave denture(s) in for three days with the exception of briefly removing four times per day to rinse with warm salt water and chlorhexidine mouth rise, clean denture(s), and replace. Begin this procedure the day following surgery.

After the first 72 hours, the denture(s) should not be worn while sleeping. Instead, the denture(s) should be placed in a moist environment (such as a glass of water) when not being used.

Should you note areas of denture irriation, contact your dentist for adjustments to the denture.

No denture adhesive should be used until sutures are removed.
